ARTICLE VII: OVERTIME

Docking/Undocking:

When and employee is called in, <u>before or</u> after his regular shift to dock or undock a vessel, he shall be paid as follows:

- a) If the docking or undocking of a vessel takes less than two (2) hours, the employee shall be paid two (2) hours at Overtime rates. *If an employee is called in 3 or more hours before or after his regular shift, a minimum of four (4) hours at overtime rate shall be paid.*
- b) If the docking or undocking of a vessel takes more than two (2) hours, the employee shall be paid for the time worked at overtime rate. If an employee is called in 3 hours or more before or after his regular shift the employee shall be paid whatever is greater, hours worked or a minimum of four (4) hours at overtime rates.
- c) Employees docking and undocking a vessel on Saturday, Sunday or a statutory holiday shall be paid a minimum of 4 hours at overtime rates.



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Article XI Pension And Welfare:

Effective March 1, 2018, the company shall contribute an additional twenty cents per hour (\$ 0.20) to the Union Welfare fund.

Effective March 1, 2018, the company shall contribute an additional twenty five cents per hour (\$ 0.25) to the Union Pension fund.

Effective March 1, 2019, the company shall contribute an additional twenty five cents per hour (\$ 0.25) to the Union Pension fund.

Effective March 1, 2020, the company shall contribute an additional twenty five cents per hour (\$ 0.25) to the Union Pension fund.

Schedule A

Effective March 1, 2018: Increase wages 3% Effective March 1, 2019: Increase wages 2.25% Effective March 1, 2020: Increase wages 2.25%

Effective March 1, 2018 Tool and Clothing Allowance will increase \$0.02 per hour Effective March 1, 2019 Tool and Clothing Allowance will increase \$0.02 per hour Effective March 1, 2020 Tool and Clothing Allowance will increase \$0.02 per hour

The parties recognize the new MSP burden, previously paid by the employee and equivalent to 2% of the payroll is being borne solely by Allied Shipbuilders Ltd.
